

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-1623

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING GOODYEAR CITY CODE ARTICLE 11-1 (OFFENSES), TO AMEND SECTION 11-1-15 (SPITTING), PROVIDING FOR CORRECTIONS, SEVERABILITY AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Code was adopted in 1973 with Ordinance No. 73 and again in 1989 with Ordinance 89-277 and both contained Section 11-1-15, Spitting; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Goodyear, Arizona have identified this code to no longer be necessary to the peace, public health and safety of the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. SECTION 11-1-15 (SPITTING) OF ARTICLE 11-1 (OFFENSES) OF THE GOODYEAR CITY CODE IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS (WITH DELETIONS SHOWN BY STRIKEOUT TEXT AND ADDITIONS SHOWN BY DOUBLE UNDERLINED TEXT)

11-1-15 Spitting—RESERVED

~~It is unlawful for any person to spit upon any of the public sidewalks or crosswalks in the City or upon any public path, by way or highway or in or on any public ground or park in the City of upon the floor or interior of any public building in the City.~~

SECTION 2. CORRECTIONS

The City Clerk, City Attorney, and/or the codifiers of this ordinance are authorized to make necessary clerical corrections to this ordinance, including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers and references thereto.

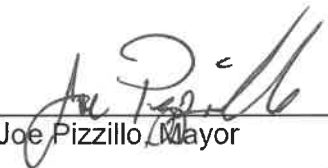
SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the ordinance or parts thereof.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective as prescribed by law.

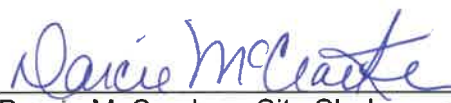
