

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-2488

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RATIFYING THE CONDITIONAL APPROVAL AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR FY 2026 ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY ANTI HUMAN TRAFFICKING GRANT.

WHEREAS, on August 18, 2025, the Mayor granted conditional approval to submit an application for grant funding with the Arizona Department of Public Safety to request funding for overtime and equipment to support anti trafficking activity, contingent upon approval by the Goodyear City Council.

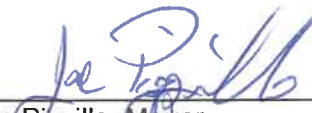
WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to apply for Department of Public Safety grant funds for anti-human trafficking task force personnel and equipment; and

WHEREAS, there is no match required from the city and pursuit of this grant is to the benefit of the citizens of the City of Goodyear

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

- SECTION 1. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to submit an application to the Arizona Department of Public Safety for an amount not to exceed \$210,000.
- SECTION 2. If the grant application is awarded, the City will enter into a Grant Agreement/ with the County to implement the projects or programs that have been approved by the County.
- SECTION 3. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute all documents relating to these applications and any grant offer resulting from such applications.
- SECTION 4. If grant funds are awarded to the City of Goodyear, the City Council hereby approves necessary budget transfers in the amount of the awarded funds.

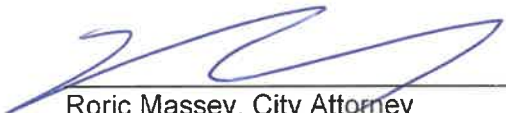
