

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-2502

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DESIGNATING THE CHIEF FISCAL OFFICER FOR OFFICIALLY SUBMITTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 EXPENDITURE LIMITATION REPORT TO THE ARIZONA AUDITOR GENERAL.

WHEREAS, A.R.S. §41-1279.07(E) requires each county, city, town, and community college district to annually provide to the Arizona Auditor General by July 31 the name of the Chief Fiscal Officer the governing body designated to officially submit the current year's annual expenditure limitation report (AELR) on the governing body's behalf; and

WHEREAS, Entities must submit an updated form and documentation for any changes in the individuals designated to file the AELR; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2024-2380 designated Jared Askelson as Chief Financial Officer for the Fiscal Year 2025 Annual Expenditure Limitation Report ("AELR"); and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2025-2468 designated Jared Askelson as Chief Financial Officer for the Fiscal Year 2026 AELR; and

WHEREAS, the governing body now desires to repeal both resolutions and designate a new Chief Financial Officer for purposes of preparing, signing, and submitting the AELR; and

WHEREAS, the City of Goodyear Mayor and Council desires to designate Michael Shoemaker, as the City's Chief Fiscal Officer.

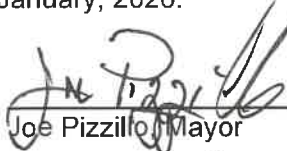
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Michael Shoemaker is hereby designated as the City's Chief Fiscal Officer for purposes of submitting the fiscal year 2025 AELR to the Arizona Auditor General on the governing body's behalf; and

SECTION 2. Resolution 2024-2380 and 2025-2468 are hereby repealed in their entirety; and

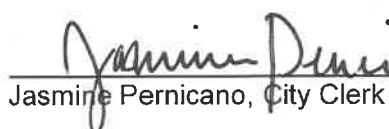
SECTION 3. Resolution 2026-2502 shall be effective upon the date of its adoption.
