

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-2511

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, SUPPORTING THE SUBMISSION OF 2026 GRANT APPLICATIONS BY ALICE COOPER'S SOLID ROCK TEEN CENTERS, LAS BRISAS ACADEMY PARENT TEACHER ORGANIZATION, NEW LIFE CENTER, ONE-N-TEN, AND SOUNDS OF AUTISM, TO THE GILA RIVER INDIAN COMMUNITY AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR THEIR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING TO SAID APPLICATIONS, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR THEIR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT AND ADMINISTER SUBSEQUENT AWARDED FUNDS, AND ANY AMENDMENTS THERETO, AS A PASS-THROUGH GRANT.

WHEREAS, Arizona's Indian Gaming Compact provides that an Indian Tribe make twelve percent (12%) of its net annual State contributions to cities, towns, or counties for government services that benefit the general public;

WHEREAS, private, not-for-profit organizations wishing to access Indian Gaming Funds ("Gaming Funds") to provide public benefits must secure sponsorship from a city, town, or county before making application;

WHEREAS, this sponsorship must be expressed in a resolution passed by the local government sponsor;

WHEREAS, Alice Cooper's Solid Rock Foundation desires to submit an application requesting \$40,000 to fund their youth nutritional education program;

WHEREAS, Las Brisas Academy Parent Teacher Organization desires to submit an application requesting \$75,000 for their Technology Innovation Stack;

WHEREAS, New Life Center desires to submit an application requesting \$10,000 for general operating and programmatic support;

WHEREAS, 1N10 Inc. dba one-n-ten desires to submit an application requesting \$6,535 to support Goodyear LGBTQ+ Youth Attending Satellite Programs; and

WHEREAS, Sounds of Autism desires to submit an application requesting \$20,000 to fund life, job, safety and stabilization skills training.

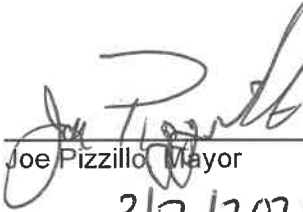
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council supports these grant requests for funding.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to accept and administer subsequent awarded funds, and any amendments thereto, as a pass-through grant. The City of Goodyear makes no guarantees beyond disbursement of funding to the non-city recipient. Upon the City of Goodyear's distribution of the awarded funds to the non-city recipient, the City of Goodyear shall be considered released from any and all claims, demands, debts, liabilities, or

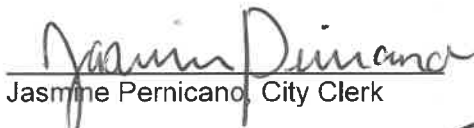
obligations that may arise in the event that the non-city recipient fails for any reason to expend the awarded funds in accordance with their grant application to the Gila River Indian Community.
