

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-2515

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE FY2025 LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT CRIME GUN INTELLIGENCE CENTER INTEGRATION GRANT FUNDS FOR \$441,884, FOR THE GOODYEAR POLICE DEPARTMENT, TO PURCHASE A MATCHPOINT ANALYSIS STATION, BRASSTRAX ACQUISITION STATION, AND A PAG800 STEREO ZOOM MICROSCOPE TO ESTABLISH A CRIME GUN INTELLIGENCE CENTER, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR THEIR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE ALL DOCUMENTS RELATING TO THE GRANT APPLICATION AND GRANT AWARD, AND AUTHORIZING A BUDGET TRANSFER TO ALLOW FOR EXPENDITURE OF THE GRANT (IF GRANT FUNDS ARE AWARDED).

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City to apply for Local Law Enforcement Crime Gun Intelligence Center Integration grant funds for assistance in purchasing a MatchPoint Analysis Station, BrassTrax Acquisition Station, and PAG800 Stereo Zoom microscope to establish a Crime Gun Intelligence Center for the police department;

WHEREAS, the projects qualify as eligible projects under the Local Law Enforcement Crime Gun Intelligence Center program; and

WHEREAS, there is no match requirement for this application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

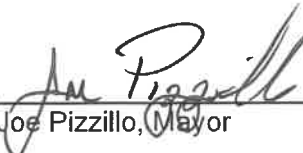
SECTION 1. The City Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to submit an application to the Department of Justice for the Local Law Enforcement Crime Gun Intelligence Center Integration for purchasing a MatchPoint Analysis Station, BrassTrax Acquisition Station, and PAG800 Stereo Zoom microscope to establish a Crime Gun Intelligence Center for the police department for an amount not to exceed \$441,884.

SECTION 2. If the grant application is awarded, the City will enter into a Grant Agreement with the Department of Justice to implement the projects or programs that have been approved by the Department of Justice.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or their designee, is hereby authorized to execute all documents relating to these applications and any grant offer resulting from such applications.

SECTION 4. If grant funds are awarded to the City of Goodyear, the City Council hereby approves necessary budget transfers in the amount of the awarded funds.
