



SUMMER RECREATION FAQ

- Where and how can I register my child(ren)?
 - Online or In-person registration only at the Goodyear Recreation Campus.
 - Goodyear residents are able to register for Summer Recreation beginning Monday, April 13 at 6:00 a.m.
 - Non-residents are eligible to register beginning Monday, April 20 at 6:00 a.m., where space is available.
- Which Summer Recreation locations will be offered for summer of 2026?
 - Desert Thunder Elementary: 16750 W Garfield St, Goodyear, AZ 85338
 - Centerra Mirage Stem Academy: 15151 W. Centerra Dr, Goodyear, AZ 85338
 - Trivium Prep: 2001 N Bullard Ave, Goodyear, AZ 85395
- Camp X-Treme Drop-In Summer Recreation
 - Goodyear High School: 17300 W. Van Buren Street, Goodyear, AZ, 85338
- What is the difference between Camp X-Treme recreation camp from the other locations?
 - Camp X-Treme site will NOT have the traditional activities such as arts & crafts. Camp X-Treme site will be highly active. Camp X-Treme site will be attending the aquatics center 1 times a week. Refer to camp calendar: Dates subject to change.
- What are the ages for this year's Summer Recreation Camps?
 - The traditional summer recreation sites ages 5 yrs-12 yrs.
 - (participant must have completed Kindergarten)
 - Camp X-Treme site ages will be 8-12 yrs.
- What are the program dates and hours for all camps this year?
 - All camps will begin Monday, June 1 and end Friday, July 17. (7 Weeks)
 - There will be no camp on Friday, June 19 and Friday July 3, 2026
 - The traditional summer recreation sites will be from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.
 - AM Half-Day Program will run from 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.
 - PM Half-Day Program will run from 12:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.
 - Camp X-Treme summer recreation will be from 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Will there be any half day/weekly programs available?
 - Yes, the traditional sites will offer half-day programs only.
 - Camp X-Treme will not have a half-day option.
- What is the cost for this year's summer recreation program?
 - All Summer Recreation Camp's
 - Residents \$320
 - Non-Residents \$385
 - Half Day (Traditional Sites Only)
 - Residents \$180
 - Non-Residents \$220
- Are there multiple children discounts?
 - Only Goodyear residents will be eligible for multi-child discounts.
 - Full Program Resident Option
 - 2+ Children: PLUS1
 - \$57.75 Off Per Child
 - Half Day Resident Option
 - 2+ Children: PLUS1
 - \$27.00 Off Per Child
 - Field Trip pack is excluded from discounts.



- When is the last day to register and/or receive a refund?
 - Friday, May 29 or until the program is full.
 - If there is a refund during camp, there will be a pro-rated refund from the date requested.
- Will there be payment plans available?
 - Yes, a minimum of \$200 per child is required at the time of registration.
 - Final payment must be made by Friday, May 22 by 5:00pm
- Will there be a waiting list?
 - Yes, you will be put on a waiting list and will be emailed when a spot is available to register within 24 hours.
- Will there be an optional field trip package offered this year? What is the cost for this year's field trip package?
 - Yes, the optional field trip pack will be available for purchase separately from the camp price.
 - Residents \$75
 - Non-Residents \$90
 - Optional field trip package is ONLY available if registered for the full day program.
 - The locations for this years camp will be Main Event, Urban Air, Goodyear Aquatics Center, Harkins X2.
- If we (parent) are running late for a field trip, can I drop my child(ren) off at the field trip location?
 - We prefer that all participants attending the field trips are dropped off at their summer recreation location at the specified time before going on the trip. That way we account for all kids correctly.
 - Due to safety protocols, we would like for all participants arriving to and from with our transportation busses with all field trips.
- What is the staff/participant ratio?
 - There will be a 15-20 participant per 1 staff ratio.
 - There will be a Maximum of 120 participants for the two traditional summer recreation sites. Camp X-Treme will be one site with 75 participants.
- What happens if I'm late to pick up my child?
 - 3 Traditional Sites
 - a. A \$10.00 late fee per child will be assessed at the following rates: 5:31-5:45 p.m. (\$10.00);
 - 5:46-6:00 p.m. (\$20.00); 6:01-6:15 p.m. (\$30.00); etc. Pick-up time will be recorded by the designated site clock.
 - Camp X-Treme
 - \$10.00 late fee per child will be assessed at the following rates: 3:31-3:45 p.m. (\$10.00);
 - 3:46-4:00 p.m. (\$20.00); 4:01-4:15 p.m. (\$30.00); etc. Pick-up time will be recorded by the designated site clock.
- Could any child sign in/out at any time as they please?
 - YES, this program is considered a "Drop-in Summer Program" labeled by the state, which children can come in/out as they please.
- How will Participant check in/out take place?
 - There will be a **Recreation Feather Flag** outside each location with staff signing in children one by one.
 - Pickup will be conducted by calling the number for each site.
- What happens if a participant or staff gets sick during program hours?
 - Any staff or participant that appear to have symptoms such as a fever, coughing, or trouble breathing, will be separated from others and will be sent home immediately.
