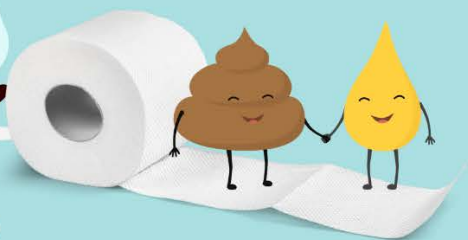

NEVER FLUSH:

- ❌ Wipes
(not even the 'flushable' ones)
 - ❌ Feminine Products
 - ❌ Paper Towels
 - ❌ Q-tips
 - ❌ Facemasks
 - ❌ Anything other than the 3 Ps:
- ✅ Paper ✅ Poo ✅ Pee



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Be kind to your plumbing.

Don't treat the toilet like a trash bin.

Cleaning wipes, baby wipes, and even "flushable" wipes, do not break apart like toilet paper. They get stuck in sewer pipes and sewer pumping equipment contributing to sewer overflows. Yuck!

Only the 3 Ps are safe to flush.

[Toilet] Paper, Poo & Pee. Used wipes and feminine products belong in the trash.

Never discard of oil or grease down the toilet or any sink drains (even if you use the garbage disposal, and not even if you chase it down with soap, hot water, etc.)

The garbage disposal only grinds up items before passing them into your sewer pipes. Grease and oil, at any temperature, will solidify on pipe walls and pumps, constricting flow.

Pour cooled oil into a disposable container. Seal and toss into the trash.

Scrape cooled grease into the trash. Wipe cookware and utensils with a paper towel before washing.

Toss the scraps. Use a strainer to catch food scraps. Toss them into the trash.

Help reduce harm to the sewer and wastewater plant. Proper disposal is as easy as **POUR, SCRAPE, TOSS.**
