

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-2525

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, DETERMINING AND ADOPTING THE FINAL ESTIMATES OF PROPOSED REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES FOR THE CITY OF GOODYEAR FOR FY2027 BEGINNING JULY 1, 2026, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2027, AND ADOPTING EXPENDITURES FOR ADMINISTRATIVE AWARD FOR FY2027.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Title 42, Chapter 17, Articles 1-5, Arizona Revised Statutes (A.R.S.), the City Council did, on May 18, 2026, make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenditures for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised by taxation upon real and personal property of the city of Goodyear;

WHEREAS, in accordance with said chapter of said title, and following due public notice, the Council met on June 8, 2026, at which meeting any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies; and

WHEREAS, it appears that publication has been duly made, as required by law, of said estimates together with a notice that the City Council would meet on June 8, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. at the Goodyear City Hall Council Chambers, at 1900 N Civic Square, Goodyear, AZ 85395, for the purpose of holding a public hearing on the 2026-2027 (FY2027) budget and the truth in taxation increase in the primary property tax levy.

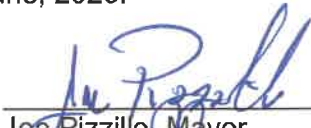
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the said estimates of revenues and expenditures shown on the accompanying schedules as Exhibit A as now increased, reduced, or changed, are hereby adopted as the budget of the city of Goodyear, Maricopa County, Arizona for FY2027 beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027.

SECTION 2. That the accompanying schedules as Exhibit B are hereby identified as specifically budgeted expenditure line items anticipated to exceed \$500,000, also known as City Schedule 10 – Expenditures for Administrative Award for FY2027 beginning July 1, 2026, and ending June 30, 2027.

SECTION 3. Resolution No. 2026-2525 shall be effective upon the date of its adoption.

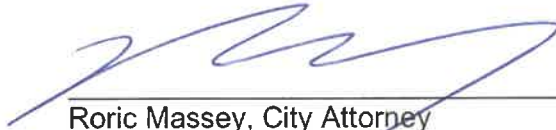
