

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-1653

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING GOODYEAR CITY CODE SECTION 3-1-5 (DEPARTMENT HEADS) CREATING A CUSTOMER SERVICE & INNOVATION DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR CORRECTIONS, SEVERABILITY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Goodyear is committed to providing the highest quality citizen services to its residents;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Goodyear recognize the creation of the Customer Service & Innovation Department is necessary to meet the goals and actions as outlined in the City of Goodyear Strategic Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Goodyear find the adoption of this ordinance be in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CITY CODE SECTION 3-1-5 (DEPARTMENT HEADS)

The Goodyear City Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new subsection, to be numbered 3-1-5(A)(16), which said subsection shall read as follows:

(16) Customer Service & Innovation

SECTION 2. CORRECTIONS

The City Clerk and the codifiers of this Ordinance are authorized to make necessary clerical corrections to this Ordinance, including, but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, ordinance numbering, section/subsection numbers, and any references thereto.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of the ordinance or parts thereof.

SECTION 4. DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

In order to preserve the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Goodyear, Arizona, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and adoption.
